PRECAUTIONS TAKEN TO SAFEGUARD AADHAAR DETAILS OF DEAD PERSONS

382. SMT. SHANTA CHHETRI:

Will the Minister of ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the precautions taken to safeguard the Aadhaar details of dead persons;
- (b) the steps taken by Government to ensure that Aadhaar details of dead persons are secured;
- (c) the details of laws that protect legal heirs from misuse/fraud caused due to Aadhaar card of dead persons; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The data of all Aadhaar holders is secured with advanced encryption technologies in a highly secured data vault in the Central Identities Data Repository (CIDR). Currently, UIDAI does not maintain death related information of Aadhaar holders.

Use of Aadhaar is governed by the provisions under the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 and any misuse of identity/fraud will be dealt with under the IPC/Aadhaar Act.
