# Aadhaar, Bank A/c Can be Linked by Mar 31 

Five-judge bench of SC to hear plea today on mandatory linking with bank accounts, SIM cards and various government schemes

New Delhi: Bank accounts hol ders will have three more months to link their account with Aadhaar number, with the government extending the deadlineto March 31,2018. Theearlier deadline was December31.
Those opening a new bank account will have maximum six months to seed their account with the 12 -digit unique identification number, the finance ministry said on Wednesday. The accounts will cease to be operational if Aadhaarnumber and Permanent Account Number (PAN) are not submitted by thenew timelines given, themi-
nistry said in a statement
The relaxation comes a day beforea five-judge bench of the Su preme Courtwillheara plea see king stay on mandatory linking of Aadhaar with bank accounts, mobile phone numbers and va riousgovernment schemes.
Ajay Bhushan Pandey, CEO of Unique Identification Authori ty of India that issues Aadhaar said the extension has been provided on people's request. "People had represented to the government that they need more time for the linking so we want to make sure that there is no in convenience," he said.
Pandey said the extension is valid not just for bank accounts but for all financial accounts.

"This is for everything, be it tement said, "After considering postal accounts, PPF, insuranc, mutual funds, ctc." However, the February deadline for linking mobile phone number remains since it's a Supreme Court order The financeministry in its sta-
chever is later, as the date of submission of the Aadhaar number, and Permanent Account Number or Form 60 by the clients to the reporting entity." Earlier in the day, the govern ment amended Prevention of Money-laundering (Maintenance of Records) Rules, 2005 to withdraw the December 31 deadline for linking Aadhaar with bank accounts and give itself freedom to notify a new date. It replaced the rule "submit the Aadhaar number and Permanent Account Number by 31st December 2017" in the Pre vention of Money-laundering (Maintenance of Records) Se Maind Ament with "submit the Aad 2017
number, and Permanent Account Number or Form No. 60, by such date as may be notified by the central government".
The extension will be available to all type of transactions co vered by the PMLA for which Aadhaar had been mandated. The prevention of money-la andering rules mandate banks and FIS to takePAN and Aadha arfor opening abank accountas well as for any financial trans action of $₹ 50,000$ and above
People who have moved the SC against Aadhaar say govern ment assurances are not enough and no coercive action sho ald be taken on either linking Aadhaarorinsistingon it forav ailing social security benefits.
