## Aadhaar-based e-sign facility at EPFO makes signing documents easier

THE EMPLOYEES' PROVIDENT Fund Organisation (EPFO) has launched free Aad-haar-based e-sign facility for employer's provident fund portal for signing documents digitally in addition to the Digital Signature Certificate(DSC)facility.The Aadhaar-based e-sign facility has been introduced as many employers were facing multiple dificulties in using the already available DSC facility.

uments uploaded on the Provident Fund uments uploaded on the Provident Fund portal, the only option available earlier was
to use the DSC of the authorised signatory of the employer.
Electronic form
ADSC is an electronic form of physicalor paper certificate such as driver's licence, passport, etc., which can be used to prove the
identity of the sender of the message and that the original message has not been altered. DSC can also be used to access online information, online services or to sign documents digitally. The Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA), Government of India, through licensed Certifying Authorities, such as eMudhra, NIC, TCS, MTNL, n-code, etc., can issue DSC. A physical hard copy application along with relevant proof of identify andaddress of the individualneeds to be submitted along with a fee with the Certifying Authority to purchase and obtain DSC. Uponvalidation, the Certifying Authority issues a DSC of the individual in a soft token (stored in a soft copy format in the computer) or in a USB ken(stored ina DSB dill ort card)
To use the DSC facility on the Provident Fund portal, a the following:
1.Purchase and obtain DSC foreach of its authorised signatory from the Certifying Authority as mentioned above

4. Set specific browser set tings in computer accessing the Provident Fund portal
5. Develop technical skills on how to use the DSC on the Provident Fund portal and troubleshooting in case of any error.
Specific software
As there were specific software and browser settings required to use the DSC facility, many employerswere facing multiple difficulties in using the DSC facility and were unable to properlyuse the digital services of the EPFO. Further, there is a fee to purchase and obtain DSC.As an kernativ., the EPF faill to ere the por facility to ease the The Aadhaa
The Aadhaar-based e-sign facility does not require any specific software or browser settings to use the facility. Once the iutered for signatory of the employer is reg istered for Aadhaar-based e-sign, the documents can be signed digitally by using the
one time pin (OTP) sent on the mobile registered with Aadhaar of the authorised registery of the employer.
To usethenewe-signfacility on the Provident Fund portal, the Aadhaar of the authorised signatory of the employer needs to be registered on the Provident Fund portal. For employers, where DSC of the authorisedsig natory is already registered, the Aadhaar based e-sign facility can beactivated by providing Aadhaar of the authorised signatory, name (as per Aadhaar), designation, gender and date of birth (as per Aadhaar) on the Provident Fund portaL.An OTP will be sent to the mobile number reg istered with Aadhaa of the authorised signatory. On submission of the OTP,Aadhaar-basede-sign will be reg-
istered and ready to use.
