

Philippines keen to learn from Aadhaar project

NEW DELHI: Visiting Philippines President Rodrigo Duterte showed keen interest in Aadhaar, India's unique identity number programme, in a bilateral meeting with PM Narendra Modi on Thursday, an official from the external affairs ministry said.

Duterte has approved 2 billion Philippine pesos in funding for his country's statistics authority to proceed with an Aadhaar-like project. A team from The Philippines was in India last week to study the Aadhaar programme, Preeti Saran, secretary east in the external affairs ministry, said.

The system was also praised by the Singapore prime minister.

"India's Aadhaar system creates many new opportunities, for instance, to harmonise India-Asean Fintech platforms or connect e-payment systems," Lee Hsien Loong wrote in a newspaper article ahead of the summit.

The thumbs-up comes at a time when the Supreme Court is hearing a slew of petitions about whether Aadhaar violates right to privacy and personal freedom.
