**Work related to Aadhaar Card in Maharashtra**

Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether it is a fact that 95 percent work related to Aadhaar Cards has been completed in Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, whether Aadhaar cards have been distributed to all the 95 per cent people; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor and by when the Aadhaar cards would be distributed to everyone?

(a) to (c) A total of 9.24 crore Aadhaars have been generated in Maharashtra against a total population of 11.23 crore (census 2011), as on 30 April 2015. Of these, 9.08 crore Aadhaar letters have been printed and dispatched as on 24 April 2015. Further, the residents have the facility of downloading e-Aadhaar from the UIDAI website ([www.uidai.gov.in](http://www.uidai.gov.in)).

Although a target of universal enrolment is being pursued, enrolment for Aadhaar is voluntary in nature; and is an ongoing process.
