The govt launched a new Aadhaar app Wednesday that will let people manage and verify their identities digitally, eliminating the need to submit physical copies of for verification. Address and phone number can also be updated on the app. **P 15**

No need for physical Aadhaar copies as new app enables digital verification.

New Delhi: Eliminating the need to submit physical copies of Aadhaar for verification or visiting Aadhaar centres for updating personal details, govt Wednesday launched the new Aadhaar app that will let people manage and verify their identities digitally.

Aadhaar details will be stored securely on mobile devices, eliminating the need to carry and submit a physical card for the purposes of verification. Changes to addresses and mobile numbers can also now be made in minutes, subject to Unique Identification Authority of India's (UIDAI) confirmation.

Users will also be able to monitor their authentication history, meaning they will be able to keep a record of the

places where their Aadhaar details has been used for verification, enhancing oversight and control over the use of their digital identity.

At the event to unveil the new app, electronics and IT secretary S Krishnan said govt is conscious of privacy concerns

and has built the platform around the principle of data minimisation and reports of Aadhaar data leaks in the past had stemmed largely from excessive data collection by third parties and not due to breaches in the central database.

"Collection of Aadhaar data by these third parties creates vulnerability. This is what we are trying to minimise," Krishnan further added.

The app allows management of up to five Aadhaar profiles on a single device linked to the same phone number. It provides users with the ability to selectively share personal information, ensuring only the necessary details are disclosed and provides a QR code identity scan feature which will enable users to scan it at authorised terminals to confirm their identity securely and quickly.

उम्र ही खड़ा की जा सकती है। इस ऐप के जरिए आधार से लिंक मोबाइल नंबर को डिजिटल तरीके से बदला जा सकता है। इसके लिए नाममात्र शुल्क देना होगा। वहीं, ऐप से ही अपडेट होना पता अपडेट कराने के लिए भी संघी प्रक्रिया से गुजरने की जरूरत नहीं है। डिजिटल रूप से पता बदलने का अनुरोध किया जा सकता है। इससे समय और मेहनत दोनों की बचत होगी। ऐप में पांच आधार रखने की सुविधा दी गई है। यह फीचर खासतौर पर परिवारों के लिए उपयोगी है।

UIDAI launches new Aadhaar app, focus on digital verification

NEW DELHI: The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) on Wednesday launched a new Aadhaar app, which it plans to merge with the existing mAadhaar app. The new app is aimed at giving users more control over their Aadhaar data while making verification and updates easier, officials said.

The app, launched on UIDAI Day, was inaugurated in New Delhi by Minister of State for Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) Jitin Prasada, who dedicated the new Aadhaar App to the nation.

The app allows users to share their Aadhaar details digitally and selectively, instead of handing over physical copies of the Aadhaar card. UIDAI said this move is meant to reduce misuse of photocopied Aadhaar cards and strengthen offline verification.

The app allows offline Aadhaar verification through a new category of entities called Offline Verification Seeking Entities (OVSEs). These entities generate a QR code that users can scan using the Aadhaar app to share verified details, without accessing UIDAI's central database. Around 18 early adopter OVSEs were present at the launch.

UIDAI officials explained with the app, a user can choose exactly what information to share. For instance, during a hotel check-in, a user can share only their name through the app instead of showing the full Aadhaar card, addressing privacy and security concerns.

Revised Aadhaar app to make sharing & storing details secure, checks faster

Pune: The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) will launch a new Aadhaar mobile application for Android and iOS, allowing citizens to securely store, share and verify details directly on smartphones.

The current mAadhaar app would be slowly phased out. Carrying photocopies or handing Aadhaar cards at hotels, hospitals or offices for identification would no longer be required.

Officials said the new app would simplify everyday Aadhaar use and give greater control over personal data. "Citizens will no longer need to carry physical Aadhaar cards or submit photocopies. Identity verification can be done directly from the phone with the consent of users," UIDAI CEO Bhuvanesh Kumar told TOI on Tuesday.

He said a key feature of the app is a single device supporting up to five Aadhaar profiles, making it easier for families to manage details of children and elderly members. The digital card stored in the app can be shown or shared through a secure and

UIDAI-signed QR code whenever proof of identity is required.

"Additionally, users can show only the required details — such as name or age — instead of giving the complete information. It means Aadhaar numbers may not be shared in most cases," Kumar said.

At present, many service providers still ask for photocopies of Aadhaar cards and keep them on record, raising concerns about data misuse. UIDAI officials said the new app addresses the issue through a strengthened offline verification system.

Hotels, hospitals, banks and other agencies registe-

red as Offline Verification Seeking Entities will be able to display a QR code asking only for specific details needed for verification. People can scan the code using the app and share the required information instantly.

"Aadhaar numbers will not be collected or stored by service providers, improving privacy and data safety," the official said, adding: "It's a secure app-based on consent framework. The control of data is in the hands of the Aadhaar holder. There is no question of compromise of personal data."

In situations where the physical presence is important — such as hotel check-

ins, hospital admissions or property registrations — the new app offers an optional face verification feature to confirm that the person is present.

Moreover, the issue of updating Aadhaar details would be resolved with the new app. "It allows users to update their registered mobile number and address without visiting centres. Service update changes like and email ID changes be added later," Kumar said.

Other features include the option to lock or unlock Aadhaar biometrics with a click, check Aadhaar authentication history and share contact details through a QR-based contact card.

Officials said the new app would make Aadhaar use more convenient for citizens, while reducing paperwork and strengthening privacy safeguards.

The mAadhaar does not provide for face authentication, verified credentials, authentication history, mobile number update and contact card, etc. Detail download and address update are common features of the two apps.

UIDAI launches updated version of Aadhaar app

The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) on Wednesday launched a revamped version of the Aadhaar app, with features such as ability to update mobile number and address online. For enhanced security, the app will also feature a one-click biometric locking feature, and allow users to share an encrypted version of their Aadhaar card from the app. The Aadhaar details of up to five people from the same family can now be uploaded and stored into a single account, with the flexibility to allow users to disclose only necessary data. The updated app will also allow users to onboard their Aadhaar card on digital wallets.

'New Aadhaar app enables age verification without data sharing'

Govt amends Swik Rules to enable private entities to provide service by using Aadhaar authentication on secure basis

NEW DELHI: The UIDAI has launched a new Aadhaar app that can be used for age verification under the Digital Personal Data Protection Act without sharing any additional data, a senior government official said on Wednesday.

Speaking at the launch of the app, the Ministry of Electronics and IT Secretary S Krishnan said the government has amended Swik Rules or the Aadhaar Authentication for Good Governance (Social Welfare, Innovation, Knowledge) Rules, 2020 to enable private entities to provide service by using Aadhaar authentication on secure basis.

"We frequently contend within the ambit of the Digital Personal Data Protection (DPDP) Act is age verification and how age verification will be done. I think we are in a position where, with the Aadhaar app, there is actually a way that age gating can seamlessly apply

The app aims to discourage use of paper copies of Aadhaar that are generally used by several entities for verifying an individual

without oversharing the data," Krishnan said.

He later said there are firms that have been put up for demonstration at the Aadhaar event.

Age gating will help online platforms, including social media platforms, online games, and e-commerce, to verify age of users for providing services to them.

The age verification will also help online platforms in cutting down access to age inappropriate content or products for children.

The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI), has launched a new app that can be downloaded from app stores on mobile phones. This will enable people and entities like hotels, cinema halls, online firms to verify an individual digitally for providing services.

The app aims to discourage use of paper copies of Aadhaar that are generally used by several entities mainly hotels, government offices for verifying an individual.

UIDAI CEO Bhuvanesh Kumar said besides easing access to Aadhaar services like address and mobile number update, the app will enable digital verification for entities and share with them information that are required for providing service.

"Mobile number update can be done now on the Aadhaar app without going to a centre. The facility of address update is already available but it has been built into this also..." Kumar said.

New Aadhaar App is Out with More Security



NEW DELHI: The government has launched an updated Aadhaar app with a host of new features including a one-click biometric lock/unlock for enhanced security and online update of mobile number and address. It allows Aadhaar details of up to five family members being uploaded on the app, full control over what data of Aadhaar is shared, and flexibility to disclose complete or selective information. The updated app will allow citizens to share an encrypted version of their Aadhaar app for various authentication purposes, without sharing visible details of their Aadhaar data. The app will also expand the use cases of digital wallets. Unique identification authority of India (UIDAI) has also released a Offline Verification Seeking Entity (OVSE) policy. Almost every district will also soon have an Aadhaar seva kendra, UIDAI CEO Bhuvnesh Kumar said. —Our Bureau

If Aadhaar can be forged, same goes for passport: SC

The Supreme Court on Wednesday objected to an argument that Aadhaar must be dropped from the documents electors are allowed to use for the purpose of identity verification during the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) exercise on the ground that they are easily forged and sourced through private agencies.

"Do you know that a passport is also outsourced to a private agency under the auspices of the Government of India? These private service centres [through which Aadhaar enrolments and updates may be done] operate under the statutory authorities or the government itself. Aadhaar is a public document. Any document can be forged. Even a passport can be forged, while issuing Aadhaar, the private centre is performing a public duty," Justice Joymatha Bagchi, a member of the Division Bench headed by Chief Justice of India Surya Kant, addressed senior advocate Vijay Hansaria.

The passport was one among the original 11 documents the Election Commission of India had allowed in its order declaring the SIR exercise.

Mr. Hansaria, representing petitioner-advocate Ashwini Kumar Upadhyay, said the court must consider its September 8, 2025, order to include Aadhaar as the 12th 'indicative' document for verification and a proof of identity.

He submitted that around 5.72 lakh privately-run common service centres carry out Aadhaar enrolments and updates, and that any person with a Class 10 qualification, basic computer knowledge and a biometric machine could operate such a centre.

Mr. Hansaria referred to

the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act of 2016 to point out that the document was not meant to verify citizenship or identity, but only as a document to boost "good governance, efficient, transparent, and targeted delivery of subsidies, benefits and services". He argued that Section 2(v) of the 2016 Act defined "resident" as any individual, including a foreigner, who has been in India for a minimum 182 days preceding the date of application for Aadhaar. "So, Aadhaar cannot prove citizenship," the senior advocate submitted.

He pointed to Section 9 of the 2016 Act to note that the provision specifically mandated that an Aadhaar number cannot be used as evidence of citizenship or domicile. "Aadhaar is an acknowledged document of identity. We have never said Aadhaar can be used as a basis of citizenship. We have always said the EC can verify Aadhaar," Justice Bagchi said.

Previously, the judge had referred to an amended Section 23 of the Representation of the People Act of 1950 to note that a person could furnish her Aadhaar number to the Electoral Registration Officer for the purpose of establishing her identity.

New Aadhaar app launches, India's digital ID coming to Google Wallet

India has launched a new Aadhaar mobile app with updated features for biometric liveness, age verification, data minimization and credential sharing.

Developed by the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI), the app allows Aadhaar number holders (ANH) to manage their digital identity on smartphones.

It supports functions such as face verification for proof of presence, biometric lock/unlock, authentication history and QR-based credential sharing. Up to five Aadhaar profiles can be managed on a single device, enabling family use, dubbed: "One Family - One App."

The dedication ceremony took place on January 28, 2026, at the Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, Janpath, New Delhi, as part of the government's ongoing push towards digital empowerment.

The event was held in the presence of Shri Jitin Prasada, Hon'ble Minister of State for Commerce & Industry and Electronics & IT.



New Aadhaar app: What changes for users and how it works

The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has introduced a new Aadhaar mobile application that changes how Aadhaar holders share, verify and update their identity. The app shifts routine Aadhaar services to a consent-based digital platform and reduces dependence on physical documents and enrolment centres.

Selective Aadhaar sharing

The app allows users to share only the specific identity details required for a transaction—such as name, age or proof of presence—instead of the full Aadhaar card. Users generate customised, digitally signed QR codes for each use case. Verifying entities do not store Aadhaar numbers, limiting data exposure.
