(a) to (c): On 29th September, 2009 the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) constituted a Biometric Standards Committee under the Chairmanship of Dr. B.K. Gairola, Director General, National Informatics Centre, Government of India with the objective of framing biometrics standards for use by the UIDAI and its partners. The Committee submitted its report on 30th December, 2009. A copy of the Report is available in the official website of UIDAI on the url:
