

Eight websites booked for illegal stock of Aadhaar info

New Delhi: The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has filed FIRs against eight unauthorised websites for promising Aadhaar-related services, and illegally collecting Aadhaar number and enrolment details from people.

The crackdown marks the first instance of FIRs being lodged by the authority against fraudulent and illegal websites touting Aadhaar-related services. The sites are aadhaarupdate.com, aadhaarindia.com, pvcaadhaar.in, aadhaarprinters.com, geteaadhaar.com, downloadaadhaarcad.in, aadhaarcopy.in, and duplicateaadhaarcad.com.

These websites were collecting Aadhaar number and enrolment details illegally from residents and promising Aadhaar services posing as entities authorised by UIDAI.

“We found that even after we ordered the shutting down of some unauthorised websites, some new websites had come up. This time, we have lodged an FIR against the erring websites,” UIDAI CEO Ajay Bhushan Pandey said.

Pandey also asked the public to use UIDAI official website (www.uidai.gov.in) for all Aadhaar-related services. ■
