



New ID proofs for train travel

New Delhi, July 5

The Railways will accept soft copies of Aadhaar and driving licence as ID proofs provided they are in a DigiLocker, a digital storage service operated by the government that enables Indian citizens to store certain official documents on cloud. The national transporter has sent a missive to all zonal principal chief commercial managers that these two identity proofs on such service will be accepted as valid proof of identity of a passenger.
